A Few Highlighted Programs

- **Outdoor Art Creator**– Scouts will use natural materials to make various forms of art.
- **Bird Watcher**– Scouts will meet an ambassador animal and investigate the unique characteristics of birds.
- **Animal Habitats**– Scouts will learn about various native habitats in Illinois and meet a few residents of those habitats.
- **Voice for Animals**– Scouts will explore ways they can be advocates for native animals.
- **Night Owl**– Scouts will learn about nocturnal species and meet a resident nocturnal animal.

- **Bird Study**–Scouts will meet an ambassador animal and investigate the unique characteristics of birds.
- **Mammal Study**–Scouts will meet an ambassador animal and investigate the unique characteristics of mammals.
- **Reptile and Amphibian Study**– Scouts will investigate the unique characteristics of herps in our area and meet a resident reptile.
- **Nature**– A general introductory program to the nature in our area. Opportunities are available to make bird feeders and meet an ambassador animal.
